












Duration




- Time and Material (T&M)

Activities




- Know and Document the customer's vision, business idea, and business use case(s)

- Requirement Feasibility Checks and Research about unknowns
- Define and Document Functional Requirements, including User Stories and UI/UX Mockups (Possibly including UI/UX Designs)
- Define and Document Non-Functional Requirements
- Define and Document Production Infrastructure Architecture Designs
- Define and Document Project Release and Sprint Planning
- Define and Document Project Risks and their mitigations
- Define and Document Project Resource Planning
- Define and Document Project Delivery Planning (Possibly including Gantt Charts)
- Define and Document Project Budget Planning


